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**Inspection Report: Shanti Aya Institute of Education Rampur Keonthal, Shimla - 11 for extension of affiliation for the session 2010-11.**

The committee Constituted by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor H.P. University Shimla -5 visited **Shanti Aya Institute of Education Rampur Keonthal, Shimla - 11** on June 5, 2010 from 11.30 a.m. onwards to consider the college for extension of affiliation for the session 2010-11 for an annual intake of 100 seats in B.Ed. Following members were present in the committee:

On the basis of the reports of the previous committees and on the physical verification of the infrastructure and interaction with a few members of the college faculty (most of the teachers were away on P. duty) and the college management the inspection team came out with the following observations:

1. College has presently 6 lecturers selected by the duly constituted selection committee of the university who are working on regular basis and are being paid basic salary as per the old scale of the UGC. EPAs are being implemented in the college. The process for filling up the one vacant post of lecturer should be expedited.
2. There is no regular principal selected by the duly constituted selection committee of the university. However, the college management has appointed the Principal at its own level. Steps may be taken to appoint Principal on regular basis.
3. The salary to the teachers and Principal is being paid through bank and credited in the individual account of the teachers.
4. As pointed out by the previous inspection committee the library needs immediate addition of at least 150 latest books having direct bearing on the B.Ed. course.
5. As per the suggestion of the previous inspection committee the college has purchased some equipment for the ET lab. However, LCD TV instead of LCD projector has been purchased which may not be able to serve the purpose of the projector.
